Ground maintenance: The working bee was cancelled for the 1st of June. A load of road base has been put in the parking area but we still need more to build up the centre to stop puddles forming.

Pro report: The train show was a success and the display was very good, a big thanks to all who put in planes for display and those who donated time and effort. Again Hobby Garage, supported us with display items, there was a lot of people go thru the display so we can hope for a good Airshow. Dave Harper demonstrated electrics and this went over very well. Catering was very successful over the electric weekend so well done Terry and Graham Ross.

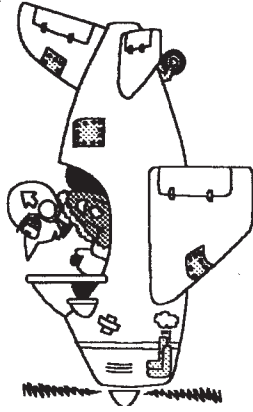
The members voted that we have a general fly in and include electrics in the fly in. Mike would like to have another electric day next may as this one was such a success.
